#### TOMATOES, A NUTRITIONAL POWERHOUSE

If you are a tomato lover you so look forward to that first bite of a delicious, flavorful, vine-ripened fruit that signals high summer. Tomatoes continue to be in season in California until the first frost, so we have a long spell to appreciate this delicious treat. Tomatoes are not only tasty, but they also contain a powerful antioxidant called lycopene, which is found only in a few other fruits. Vitamin C and potassium are also part of the tomato nutritional complex.

Locally grown tomatoes are your best option for health and taste. Big Ag has accidentally bred out flavor in its attempt to create a perfectly round, pest-resistant fruit that can ship and keep well. Plus, grocery store tomatoes are often picked too early so that they can arrive at the store in prime condition and not overripe. Most local tomatoes are tops for flavor and nutritional value. Lycopene content is higher in local fruit.

Like all antioxidants, lycopene stomps on free radicals, which play a role in cancer, heart disease, and other ailments associated with aging. Men who eat tomatoes almost every day have a significantly lower rate of prostate cancer. Lycopene may also protect the skin from sun damage, and possibly helps women to maintain bone mass.

You get more lycopene, and absorb more of it, when tomatoes are cooked. One half cup of tomato sauce actually has three times as much lycopene as one large tomato. To enhance the absorption of fresh tomatoes, puree or crush them which breaks down cell walls. Also adding olive oil, avocado, or cheese to tomato dishes helps in the absorption of lycopene which is a fat-soluble carotenoid. Other colored tomatoes have health benefits too. Orange tomatoes pack beta-carotene, and yellow tomatoes contain lutein which benefits the eyes. Some people are allergic to tomatoes, especially the skin and seeds. This usually only occurs when large amounts are consumed.

Folks with arthritis, especially rheumatoid arthritis, often think that they should avoid tomatoes and other nightshade vegetables (potatoes, peppers, and eggplant) because they have heard that they cause inflammation that leads to joint pain. This fear comes from the fact that nightshade family veggies contain solanine, which can be toxic in large amounts. However, these plants have very low levels of solanine, and no real research has proven that these nightshade members cause inflammation. In fact, the phytochemicals in tomatoes actually have an anti-inflammatory effect.

So, before the season ends, indulge yourself in some of summer and fall's most desirable fruits. Besides eating out of hand, tomatoes star in such dishes as gazpacho, ratatouille, white bean dishes, and of course pasta and soups.

We currently carry *Gowans* hard cider, which is the product of the younger generation after 140 years of growing and selling apples! We also have *Testa* wine from Calpella, where Maria Martinson acquired the property of her grandparents, and has continued to grow grapes and produce excellent wines. She even names the wine in honor of them. *Boeket* wine is another wine from Mendocino County that pays homage to their Dutch ancestors, who were the first to plant agriculture roots in the Northern California wine country back in the 1800's. We are excited here at Mariposa to add yet another great wine from Mendocino County. It is a Pinot Noir from *Elkfield* winery.



**Gabi** Khoury, who settled in Mendocino County to grow grapes in 1978, after looking for "the perfect spot" found a great location off of Highway 20, that is nestled in a unique microclimate, and surrounded by mountains and wildlife. He has 15 years of growing organically certified grapes and is the founder of *Elkfield* winery. His children, Jane and Nicholas, both followed in their fathers' footsteps and are continuing with the winery but have moved forward with regenerative agriculture by becoming certified biodynamic.

Jane Khoury has a Bachelor of Science in Viticulture and Enology from U.C. Davis, as well as a Masters of Business Administration in Wine business from Sonoma State University. She has also studied under French winemakers in the French wine regions of Champagne, Burgundy, and Bordeaux. To top that off, she is an Intensive Care Unit Registered Nurse.

**Nicholas** Khoury also studied at University of Davis Viticulture and Enology. He is also a practicing Dentist in Ukiah.

**Together** they are creating some wonderful wines and doing an amazing job! We currently carry the Pinot Noir, which is an elegant, fruit-forward wine, reminiscent of candied fruit and sweet oak. They will soon be releasing a Merlot and I am looking forward to having it here at the store.

#### **Chicken Preparation Tips**

#### Don't:



Wash the Chicken: Rinsing the chicken is an ideal way to spray pathogens all over your kitchen. It doesn't clean the pathogens off of the chicken anyway.

**Use an Old Plastic Cutting Board:** Plastic cutting boards must be run through a dishwasher to be sanitized. Wood can be equally cleaned with a good hand washing.

**Forget to Wash Your Hands:** You can't wash your hands too much in the kitchen, especially when handling meat. Be sure to get under the fingernails and jewelry too.

**Take It Out of The Oven When It Looks Done:** Check for doneness with a thermometer. It should read at least 165° F in the thigh and the thickest part of the breast.

**Pick A Chicken from The Front of The Shelf:** Check the sell-by dates, and choose the freshest bird possible **Let Your Chicken Sit Around:** Cook your chicken within 2 days of bringing it home, unless you plan to freeze it. Your home refrigerator is not as cold as those in the store, and you open the door often, warming the interior.

**Trim All of The Fat:** Chicken fat is high in palmitoleic acid, which is thought to be an immune booster. It is also low in oleic acid, which is good for your cholesterol. Lastly, poultry fats are low in polyunsaturated fatty acids, making them more stable for higher heat cooking
